OBTAINING SPANISH RECOGNITION

Australian EA Professional Engineer Members.

1. Pre-membership

- a. EA Members/CEng would need to go through qualifications homologation process, performed by the Ministry, to establish the qualification gap (if any). This is applicable for the holders of both, WA accredited Bachelor and Master degrees.
- b. CGCOII provides an opinion regarding the homologation, but the final decision is up to the Ministry.
- c. If there is a gap identified, then EA Member/CEng can be admitted to CGCOII as a “pre-member”.
- d. CGCOII helps Pre-members in establishing the best pathway to full membership, based on the result of the homologation process.

For the members from Engineers Australia we will need next documentation:

- primary piece of identification, such as a passport photo page, current driver licence
- degree certificate (testamur) – original and official Spanish translation
- academic transcript – original and official Spanish translation
- current CV or resume
- Engineers Australia membership certificate** – original and official Spanish translation.
